Wednesday, February 14, 2024

- Tom Saucer of Nant-y-Derwyddon is working on putting together a combat archery practice. Anyone interested is encouraged to contact him.
- Barony needs to purchase a \$45 Honeywell cash box with a \$4.69 receipt book with carbons. Vote passed.
- Fundraising to cover baronage travel expenses: how's that going? How much did the tutu fundraiser raise?
- Arts & Sciences report: Atlantian 12th Night was wonderful. Signy Jarnadottir became the Queen's royal bard. [Chronicler's note: Song Qingzhao, well-known in Hawkwood, became the King's bard on this occasion as well.] Scrollwork for Baronial Birthday is ongoing.
